Could you be eligible for a £140 rebate from your energy Supplier? Each of the large energy Suppliers is required by the UK Government to have a scheme in place called The Warm Home Discount. This is paid to some customers automatically, if they receive certain benefits. However households with an annual income of less than £16,190, and with someone of pensionable age or a child of under 5 living in the house, are considered, but only if the company is contacted by the customer.
